

“More information on the processing of images captured by video surveillance systems and data required for controlling entrance to buildings.”

For what purpose?

Image processing through video surveillance systems and other data collected in order to register entrance to the premises is carried out for security and entrance control purposes

Why can they do so?

Image processing for video surveillance and entrance control purposes is based on the legitimate interest of Morteros Tudela Veguín, S.A. to protect its artistic and material property, as well as to guarantee the safety of its employees and all others who enter their property.

Who else has access to your data?

The video surveillance service is provided by the private security company SERCOINFO SEGURIDAD, S.L., which has access to the data through Morteros Tudela Veguín, S.A. The images may be provided upon request to Law Enforcement Authorities or judges and courts in the course of investigations or proceedings, or when necessary to exercise or protect the rights of Morteros Tudela Veguín, S.A. or third parties that may be affected.

What are your rights and where can you demand them?

The right to access your data and be informed about its use.
The right to correct data which is incomplete or incorrect.
The right to delete data when it is no longer necessary, in accordance with law, consent is withdrawn or you object to its use, amongst other reasons.
The right to object to the processing of data based on personal conditions, in which case once the reasons have been examined the data will no longer be processed.
The right to restrict the processing of the data while assessing the legal validity of the request, opposition to erasure or you wish them to be conserved in order to exercise or defend claims.
Withdrawal of consent for the processing of your data, which shall not affect the processing carried out up to that time.
You can request to exercise these rights by contacting SERCOINFO SEGURIDAD, S.L. at C/Hacienda de Pavones, 248 – 28030 Madrid for matters relating to video surveillance images or by contacting Morteros Tudela Veguín, S.A. with the contact details provided for other matters.

You can also submit a complaint to the Spanish Data Protection Agency (AEPD) if you think that your data is not being processed in compliance with law.

For how long will your data be kept?

Your data will be erased within one month after its recording or collection, with the exception of those images or recordings which must be kept if required during the course of an investigation until it concludes or if responsibilities are established arising from the recorded activities.
